

# DIY Kennel Mat

**Supplies:** Fleece Scraps 3" and wider  
Sewing Machine and Thread  
Ruler, Marker and Pencil  
Fabric Scissors and Iron

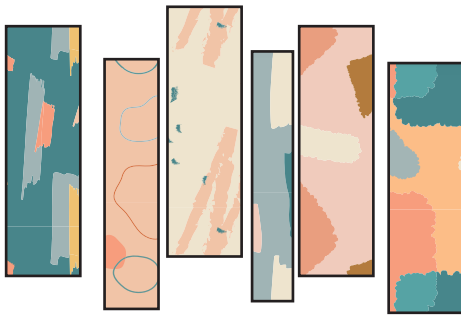

For small dogs cut the strips 14"

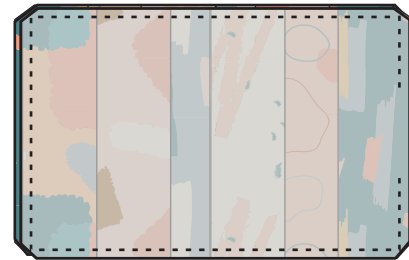
For medium sized dogs cut the strips 24"

For large dogs cut the strips to 36"

You'll need enough strips to make two larger pieces to work with. The finished size should be a square – such as 14" x 14" or a rectangle such as 14" x 18". Remember to calculate in a seam allowance when figuring the finished size.

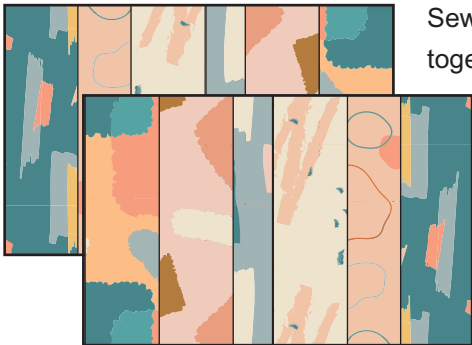


Note:

the stretch  
going in one  
direction the  
overall shape  
will be better.



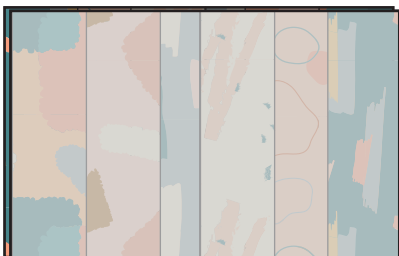

Sew the strips  
together. Press.



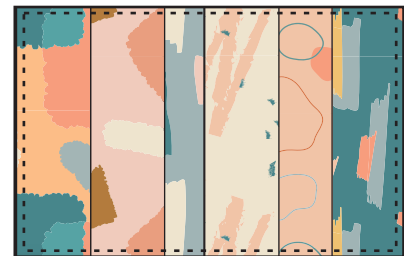

Line up pieces  
right sides  
together. Pin.

Stitch all the way around 1/2"  
from edge leaving a 5" opening.  
Clip corners

Turn right side out. Poke  
pencil into the inside corners  
to square off. Stitch all the  
way around 1/4" from edge.
