

Comfort Bear

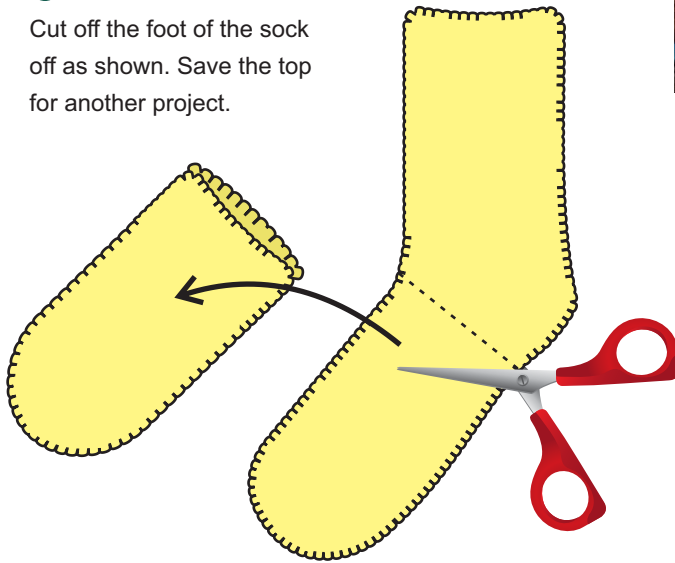
Supplies:

- 1 Fuzzy Sock
- 10" of 1/4" Ribbon
- Scrap of Black Felt
- Heavy Duty Thread and Needle for Hand Sewing
- Polyester Filling



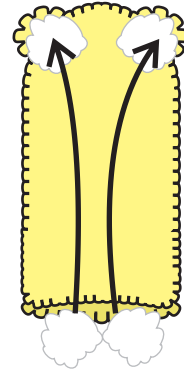

Cut off the foot of the sock off as shown. Save the top for another project.



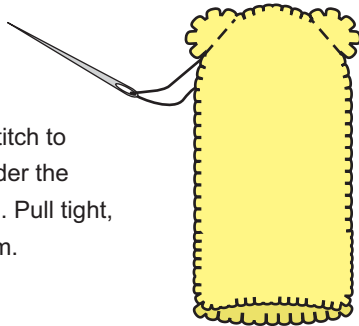

Push a small ball of polyfill into the corners for ears.



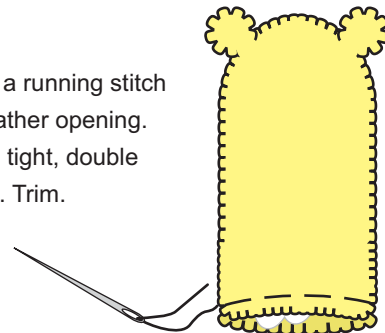

Use a running stitch to gather fabric under the filling in the ears. Pull tight, double knot. Trim.



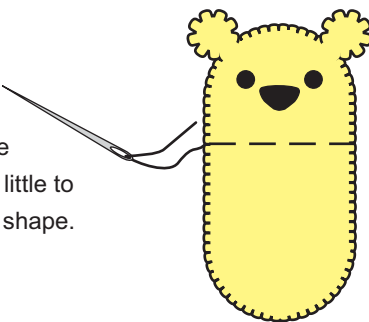

Use a running stitch to gather opening. Pull tight, double knot. Trim.



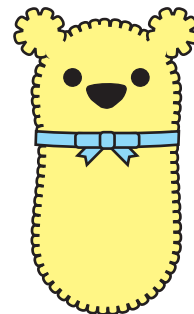

Use a running stitch to gather fabric around the neck. Pull just a little to create a peanut shape. Knot and trim.

Use pattern to cut felt eyes and nose. Use fabric glue to attach. Tie ribbon around neck. Tack in place with glue.
